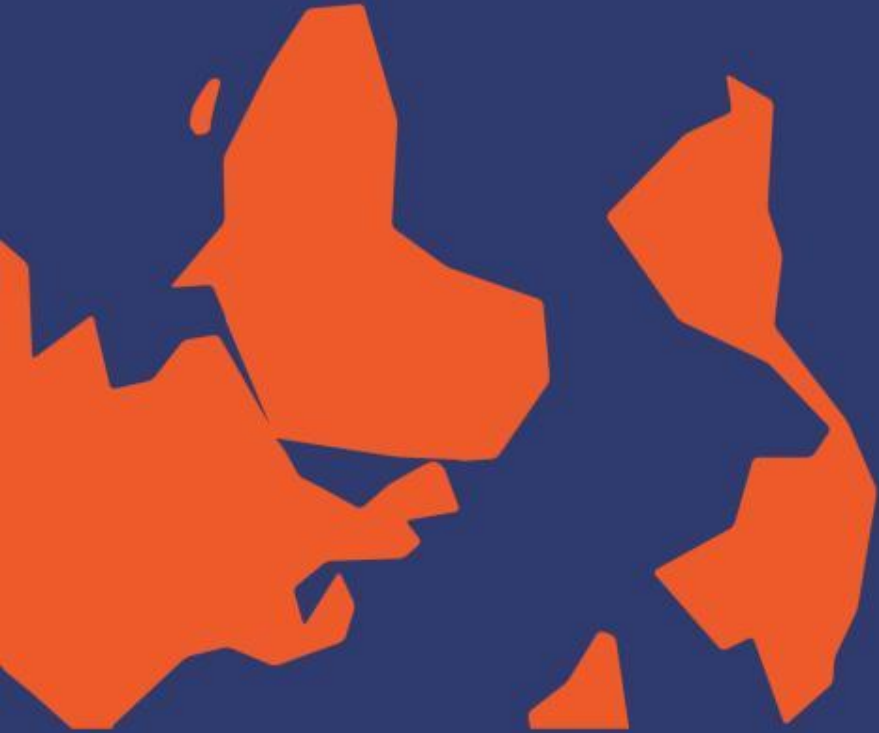

SIDI is a social investor created in **1983** by the French **CCFD-Terre Solidaire** to **improve the living conditions of vulnerable populations** in developing countries, through the **creation and strengthening of income-generating activities** at the individual and community level.

36 countries

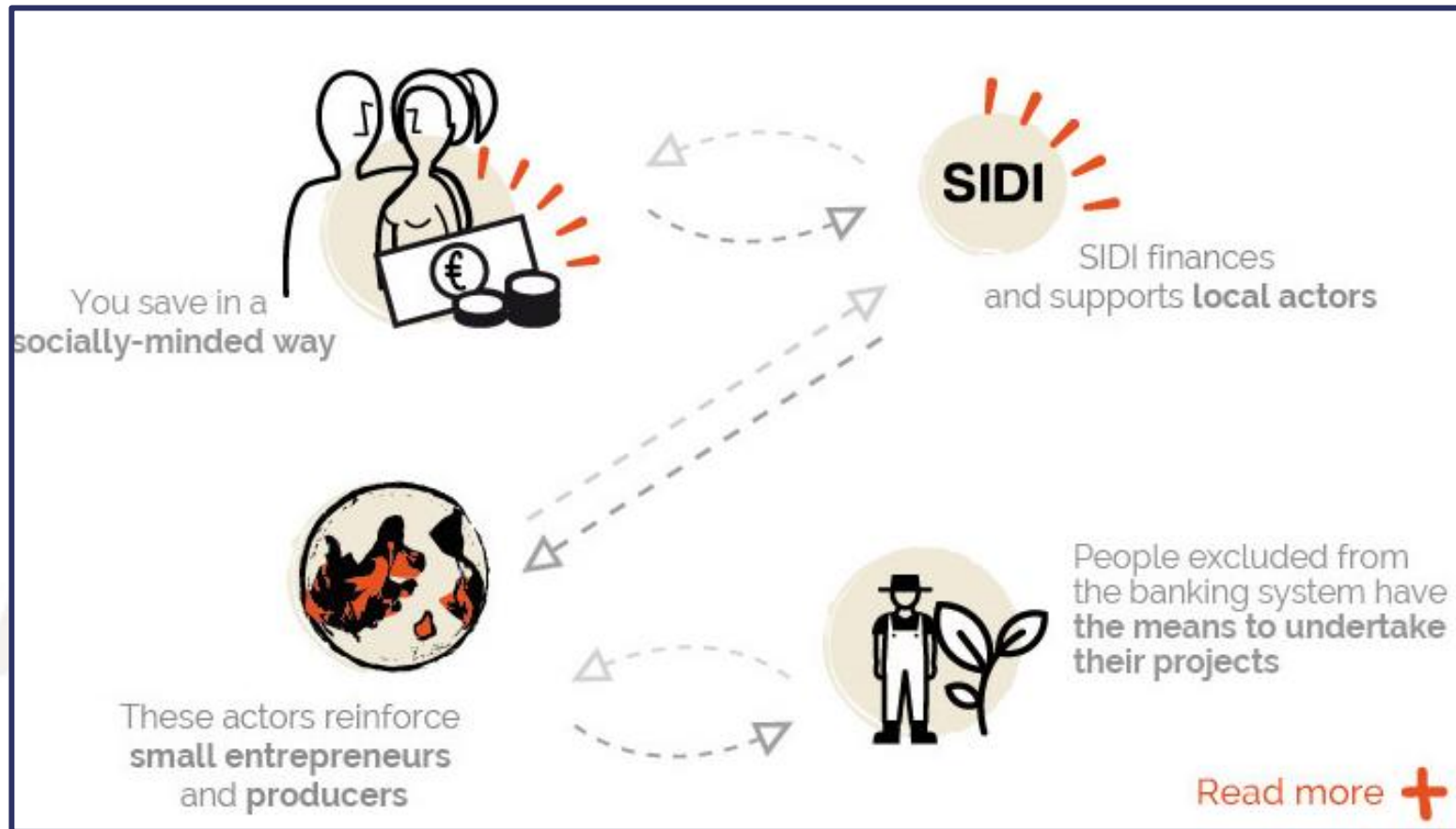

Direct financing

Focus on rural areas :

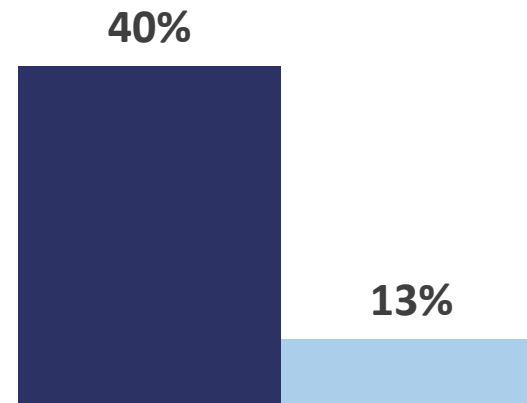
- area neglected by local banks

■ *Other microfinance investment funds at 31/12/2020*

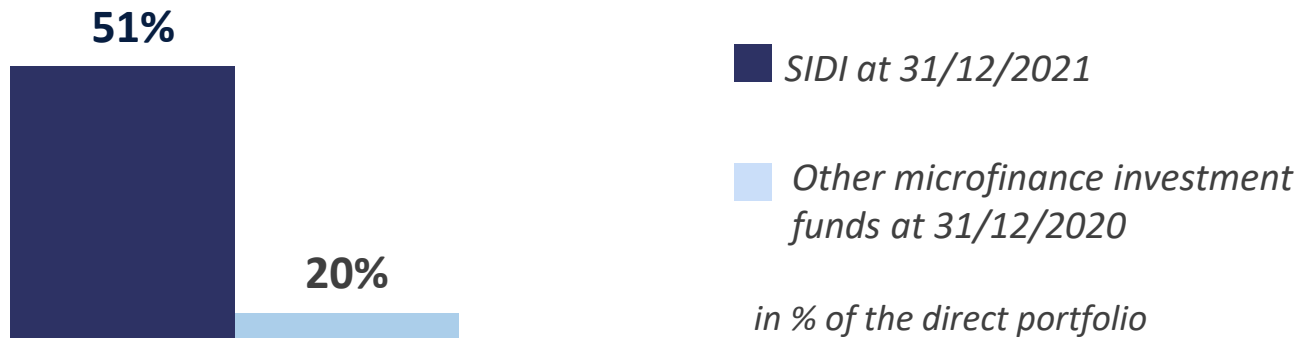
in % of the direct portfolio

❖ Financial support geared towards empowerment

- **Long-term loans**

In 2021, **50%** of loans had a duration of **more than 36 months**

❖ Commitment to the Ecological and Social Transition (EST)

The **EST** is a general institutional approach aimed at the **integration and progressive achievement** of **ecological and social objectives** that SIDI shares with its partners and its financial solidarity chain.

Example : Supporting a South African MFI in measuring the evolution of its clients' poverty

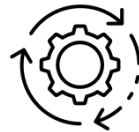
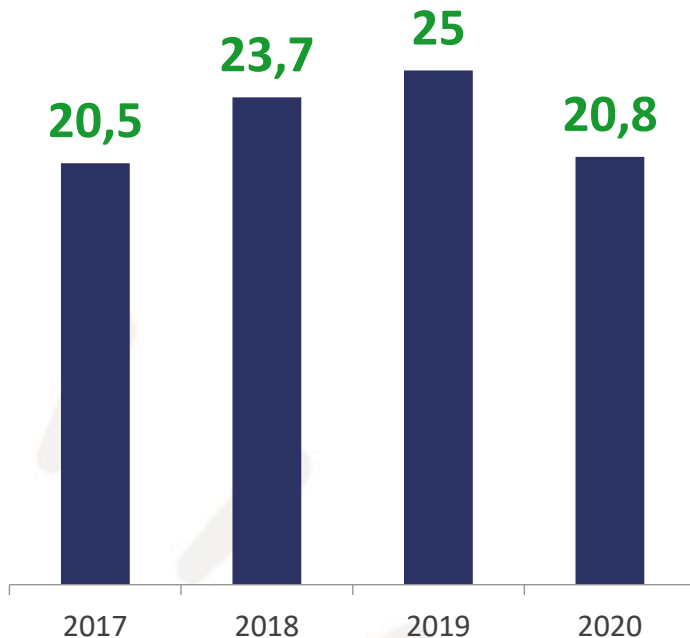

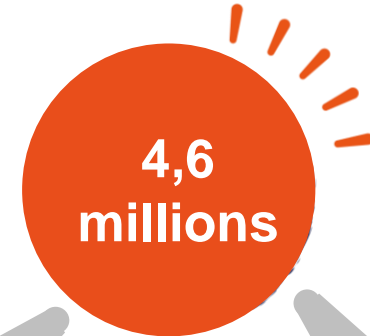
